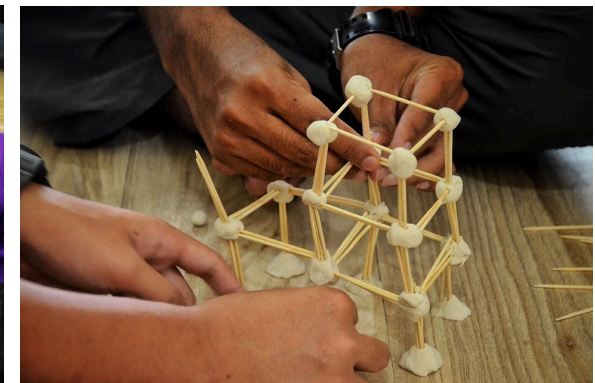
## Campfire & Performances

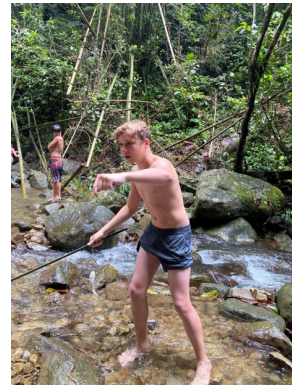
